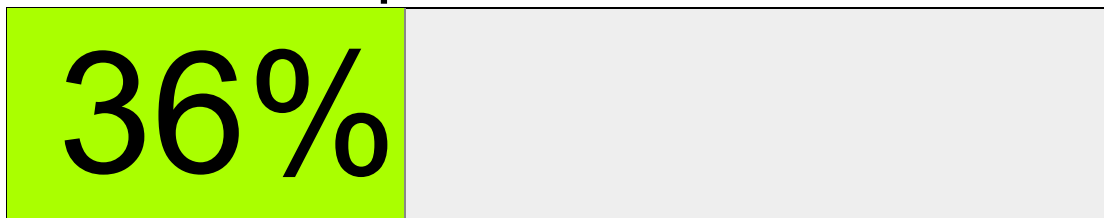


The Mars Effect

Total Uncooperativeness:



What does that mean? Simply put, the higher the number the more important it is for you to put conscious effort into being more cooperative and self-sacrificing; subjugating your own individual desires to the wants and needs of the people you relate with closely on a day-to-day basis. Conversely, the lower the number, the safer it is for you to consider yourself justified in standing up for your own wants and needs.

I personally know people with cooperation problems in their relationships. Their scores are in the upper 60s. Not that he represents the most uncooperative person in the world, but it is interesting to note that Adolf Hitler's score is 74. On the other end of the spectrum, I know people who are very cooperative in relationships, their scores are in the lower 40s and 30s. Mother Teresa is a great example of extreme selflessness and cooperation. Her score is 19. 50%, as you would expect, is "normal" and "average."

Please realize that, although this is the most thorough report of its kind, still it only focuses on one aspect of your horoscope: the role of independence in specific regard to personal relationships. Other factors outside the scope of this report can also modify the true end result of how selfish or selfless you are in your relationships, and

certainly play an important role determining your independence in things besides relationships.

In the rest of this report, I will explain the various components that go into creating your "Total Uncooperativeness" score. I will end the report by giving a few suggestions how to work with your score.

THE MARS EFFECT



Mars generates all our *energy*. Energy becomes passion. Passion becomes ambition. Ambition makes us strive to succeed. In the course of doing so, we must focus. By focusing on our own ambitions and success, we can devalue the wants and needs of other people; we become uncooperative. Thus, in astrology, Mars is the source of uncooperative independence.

"The Mars Effect" is a way to evaluate just how overly independent and uncooperative we really are in our daily relationships. Its relevance

is not limited to marriage, but since marriage is the foremost of our cooperative relationships, it is particularly sensitive to The Mars Effect.

The basic idea is to look at your horoscope and evaluate how intensely the source of independence (Mars) influences the focal points of cooperation and mutual support. Basically, these are:

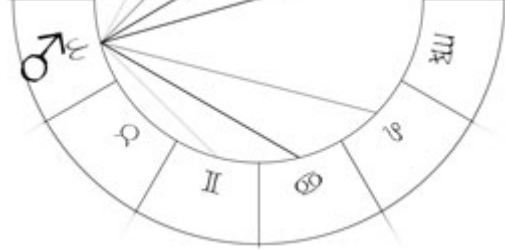
1. The seventh & second signs from the Ascendant
2. The seventh sign from Venus.
3. The seventh & second sign from the Moon.

The Mars Effect increases the more Mars influences the three key focal points in your horoscope, either by being physically close to them ("*conjunction*") or by having a clear line of sight to them ("*aspect*"). In modern India this has been severely dumbed down; ignoring the second and third focal points and estimating aspects by sign, without reference to degrees. The resulting haphazard assessments, of course delivered with boisterous certainty, mainly serve to scare the pants off people who now think their relationships are forever doomed.

This report is *not* one such hasty guesstimation! I calculate all aspects by *exact degree* using the *natural cusps* of each house, as recommended in Parashara Hora, the great tome of astrological wisdom from ancient India. Neither do I

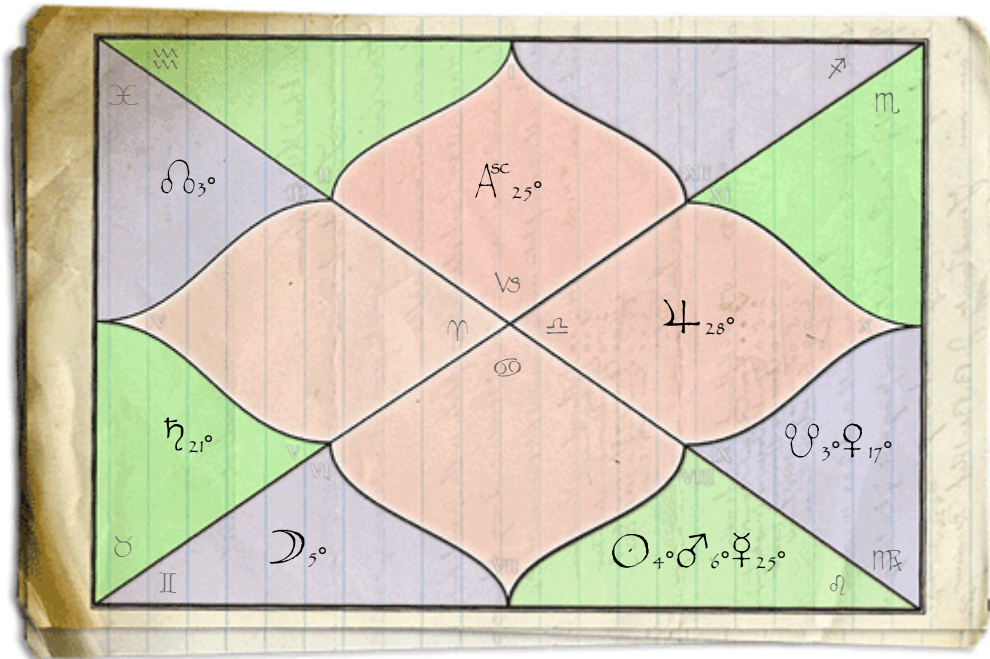


approximate *conjunctions* by sign. I calculate them with increasing intensity as Mars comes closer to the key point (i) by sign, (ii) by lunar mansion, and (iii) by harmonic ninth, "*navamsha*."



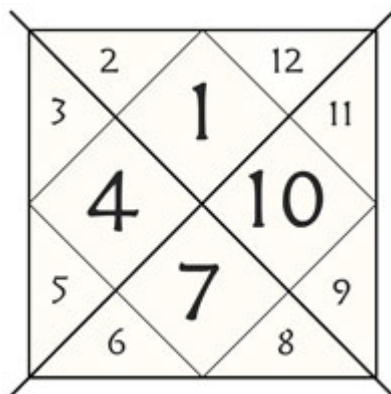

Above is a diagram of where all the planets were in the sky at the moment you were born - a "Vedic birth chart." This is the chart that I use to evaluate your Mars Effect.

It's not possible to learn to "read" this chart overnight, but here is how to make some sense out of it. There are three things shown here: houses, zodiac signs, and planets. The diamonds and triangles are the houses. The small symbols in the corners of the houses are the zodiac signs, they "build" the houses. The bigger symbols in the middle of the houses are the planets, they "occupy" the houses.



This graphic shows how the houses are numbered, counterclockwise from the top. The zodiac sign symbols are: ♈ - Aries, ♉ - Taurus, ♊ - Gemini, ♋ - Cancer, ♌ - Leo, ♍ - Virgo, ♎ - Libra, ♏ - Scorpio, ♐ - Sagittarius, ♑ - Capricorn, ♒ - Aquarius, ♓ - Pisces.

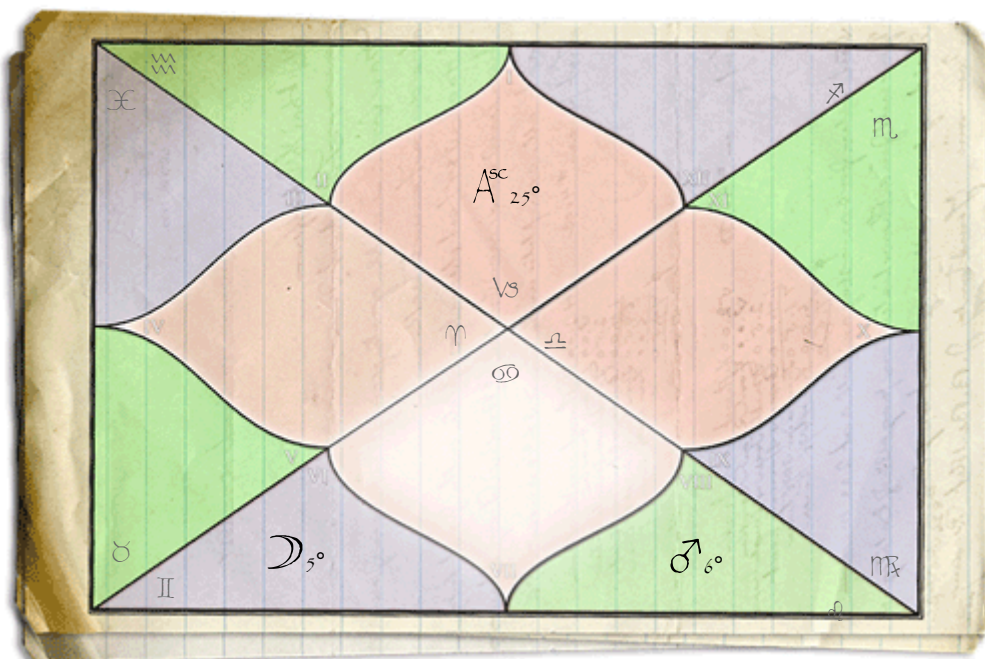
Here are the planetary symbols: ☉ - Sun, ☾ - Moon, ☿ - Mercury, ♀ - Venus, ♂ - Mars, ♃ - Jupiter, ♄ - Saturn, ♃ - Rahu, ♁ - Ketu.

All of your astrological information is encoded, in an extremely dense symbolic format, into the symbolism of this chart. It is a blueprint of all the *karma* that will affect you during this lifetime.

"Vedic" charts use the sidereal zodiac, the one that represents the true stars

you see up in the sky. It also uses the ancient *whole-sign* house system where each sign *creates* each house. If you are not very familiar with various systems this may confuse you and seem like a "different" chart from the Western one you may be used to. Truth is, though, that western and eastern charts are just two ways of saying the same thing. I use the eastern, "vedic" chart and systems.

PRACTICALITIES OF RELATIONSHIPS



First, I evaluate your horoscope using the Ascendant (A^{sc}) as the anchor point. The Ascendant is the degree in the zodiac that was rising in the east when you were born. It is the anchor point for all things tangible and practical in life.

Practical Uncooperativeness:

23%

There are three things that go into arriving at this score for how cooperative you are concerning practical details. Foremost is the impact Mars has upon your "Seventh House," the seventh sign from your Ascendant. In your horoscope **Cancer** ($\♋$) is your seventh house. 25° in Cancer in particular is the *cusps*, or "front door," of your seventh house. Mars has a 0% influence on this focal point.

Mars' Effect on Seventh House Cusp:

Another factor is Mars' influence on your "Second House," which is the focal point of family and people who support you. 25° in Aquarius ($\♒$) is the *cusps* of this house. Mars has 100% influence on this cusp.

Mars' Effect on Second House Cusp:

100%

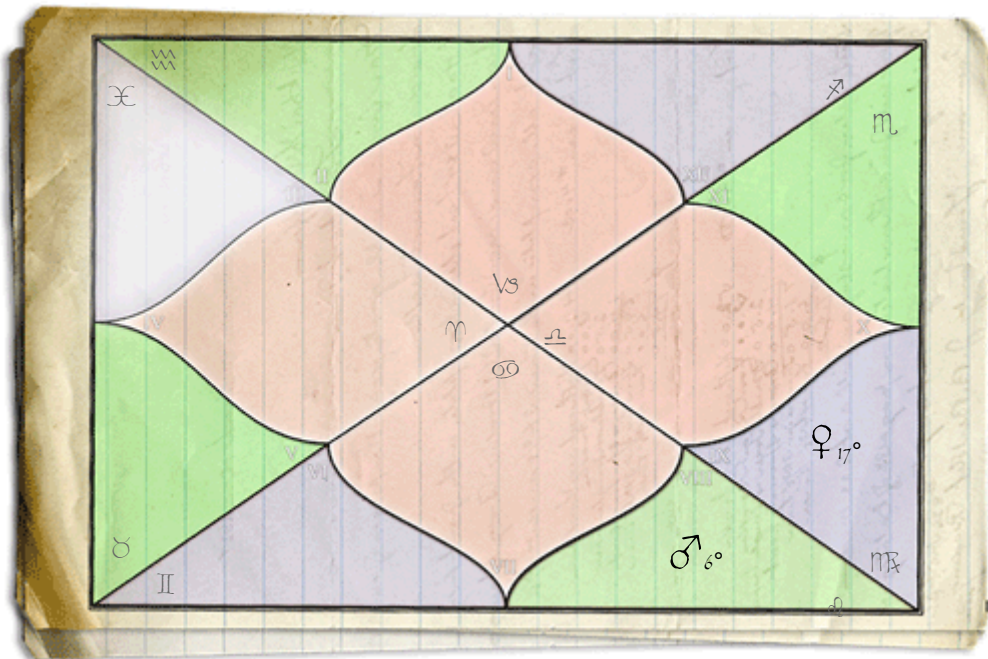
The third factor in this category is how intensely Mars affects the planet who *owns* your Seventh House is also somewhat

consequential - in your case, **Moon (♃)**. Mars has 2% influence here.

Mars' Effect on Seventh Lord:

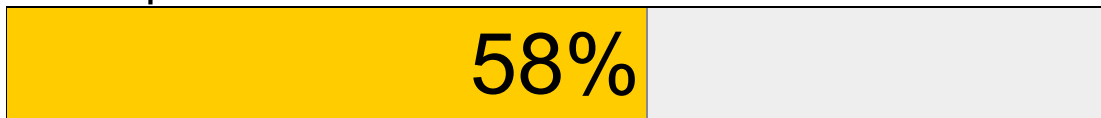


PEACE, LOVE & HARMONY



Next, I evaluate your horoscope using Venus (♀) as the anchor point. Venus is the planet of cooperation, harmony, peace and love.

Uncooperativeness in Love:



Two things go into arriving at this score. Foremost is the impact Mars has upon the cusp of the seventh sign from Venus. **Pisces** (♓) is the seventh sign from where Venus sits in your horoscope. The *cusp* or "front door" of this sign is 17° Pisces, exactly 180° from your Venus. Mars influences this point with 82% intensity.

Mars' Effect on Venus' Seventh Sign:



The influence of Mars upon Venus herself is the second factor. Mars influences your Venus with 10% intensity.

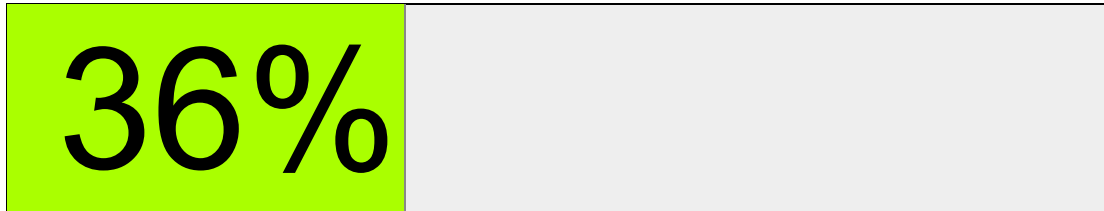
Mars' Effect on Venus:

Combining all of the above with appropriate mathematical weight, I arrive at your combined "Total Mars Effect." Which is what I started out the report by telling you:

RECOMMENDATIONS

ACCEPT IT

If you have a much higher score than you thought you would, the most important advice I can give you right now is this: **"Accept it!"** The biggest problem for people with too much Mars Effect is that they refuse to *accept* other's evaluations of them. "You don't even know me!" is the typical response a highly Mars affected person upon being told they are too selfish.

So, first of all **accept it**. This is a third party, impartial astrological evaluation of you based on a purely mathematical interpretation of your birth chart. It is not personally biased in any way, shape or form. And it has proved accurate over hundreds of horoscopes ranging from Mother Teresa to Adolf Hitler. If this report says that you are overly uncooperative (total score over 50%) be brave and bold enough to accept it and *do something* about it. Make conscious efforts to consider the desires of other people *before* you take care of your own!

FIND BIRDS OF A FEATHER

Relationships between people with similar Mars Effect scores *work well*. If Person A has a low Mars Effect score and marries Person B who has a high Mars Effect score, its not going to be nice. Person A is going to always feel ignored and unloved and Person B is going to always feel nagged, restricted, and henpecked. But if Person B marries someone with a similarly high score, they will get along well because they each will instinctively give the other personal space to thrive in. Similarly, if Person A marries another person with a low Mars Effect, they will have a wonderfully cooperative relationship where they seldom leave one another's side or do anything separate from one another.

So, regardless of what your score is, find other people with a similar score, and forge long-term relationships with *them*.

MEDITATE & PRAY

Reality is created by our minds, so what you meditate on and pray for is what soon becomes your reality. If you have a higher uncooperativeness score than you would like, you can meditate and pray to make it better. The Parashara Hora specifically recommends meditating on this ancient prayer to the deity of Mars:

अग्निर्मूर्धा दिवः ककुत्
पतिः पृथिव्या अयम्
अपां रेतांसि जिन्वति

*agnir mūrdhā divah
kakut patih pṛthivyā ayam
apām retānsi jinvati*

Mars, you are the very face of fire in the summit of the heavens. Only by your strength do I gain the power to thrive on Earth. May you activate the watered seed.

- Rg Veda (8.44.16)

The crucial point in this meditation is the "watered seed." Meditate on using your ambitions, strengths, courage, and willpower to help *other people* "activate" themselves, come to life and thrive.
